General: awake, thin NAD
 HEENT: sclera anicteric, oropharynx clear without lesions, mucous membranes moist
 Neck: supple, no lymphadenopathy, no thyromegaly, no JVD, no carotid bruits
 Cardiovascular: regular rate and rhythm, no murmurs, rubs or gallops
 Lungs: clear to auscultation bilaterally, without wheezing, rhonchi, or rales
 Abdomen: soft, non-tender, non-distended, normoactive bowel sounds, no palpable masses, no hepatosplenomegaly, no rebound or guarding

Extremities: no clubbing, cyanosis, or edema

Neuro: A+O x 1, no gross motor/sensory deficits
 Skin: no rashes or lesions noted
