SUMMARY OF THESE 7/8/22 EMAILS

As per these 7/8/22 emails, according to Lynn Kay, the care manager was dismissive of the health concerns she raised about her mom. Lynn reported various issues, such as her mom's noticeable fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain in her right arm/shoulder, decreased appetite, and frequent nighttime urination. Despite these reports, the care manager allegedly did not take appropriate action and only called 911 after persistent urging from Lynn. This perceived negligence contributed to Elaine's health decline and subsequent hospitalization.

This is a series of forwarded emails discussing the care and legal guardianship of Elaine Mae Kapusta-Lynn's mom.

Lynn Kay, the daughter, expresses her concerns about the negligence of Liz Shifflett-care manager fully overseeing her mom's health with Lynn having to request care for her mom through the care manager and details Lynn's long-term role in caring for her mom.

Cary Cucinelli, an attorney, informs Lynn of there now being a 7/8/22 court order mandating her cooperation with professional caregivers and warns of potential police involvement if she obstructs their duties.

The emails highlight the ongoing legal and personal struggles surrounding Elaine's care and well-being.

There were a series of forwarded emails between Lynn Kay, Cary Cucinelli, and other involved parties regarding the care and well-being of Lynn's mom.

Lynn details her extensive role as her mom's primary caregiver and advocate, expressing concerns about the current care manager's negligence and the potential consequences for her mom's health.

The emails also include a court order mandating Lynn to cooperate with professional caregivers assigned to her mom and the legal implications of non-compliance.

The correspondence highlights the ongoing struggle to ensure proper care and the emotional toll on Lynn as she fights for her mom's life and future.

Liz Shifflett, the care manager in this situation is responsible for providing professional care to Lynn's mom in her home. However, Lynn expresses significant concerns about the care manager's performance, alleging negligence and dismissiveness regarding her mom's health issues.

Cary Cucinelli disrespectfully disregards what Lynn has attested to in this email and also the 7/7/22 emails.

With Cary Cucinelli having so little respect for both Lynn and Elaine that she fails to inform the court of Lynn's stating that Liz Shifflett caused Elaine to become gravely ill requiring the demand from Lynn for hospitalization.

This Legal Misconduct in Cary Cucinelli concealing this fact as stated by Lynn and confirmed by 30 text messages between Lynn to Liz Shifflett being entirely ignored.

This miscarriage of justice and "the failure of Cary Cucinelli" to ever notify Lynn about "the baseless Emergency Petition on 7/4/22 with a Court Hearing on 7/5/22 which Lynn was not only never notified, also Cary Cucinelli also concealed the actual Petition where all baseless and entirely misleading allegations both slandered and defamed Lynn in public without Lynn ever being informed ever of this.

This 7/8/22 Materially Breached the Settlement Agreement permanently.

The concealments and coverups of her filing an entirely baseless and destructive Emergency Petition has ruined both Lynn's life and her mom's life as nothing, but medical abandonment and negligence has occurred ever since without Lynn having full power over her mom and her health.

The legal misconduct of Cary Cucinelli and all fiduciaries "failure to investigate in their all never doing any due diligence" at all and "failure to disclose" and "failure to inform" this court then escalated to "fraud upon the court" and "malicious prosecution with threats to both Lynn's and Elaine's life and home and as a direct result of "THE LIES OF CARY CUCINELLI AND ALL FIDUCIARIES" Lynn's and her mom's well-being and both of their lives were further unceasingly threatened and decimatedly destroyed to present day.

Lynn accuses the care manager of failing to respond adequately to her mom's declining health and not taking appropriate actions when her mom needed medical attention. Despite these concerns, the court has ordered that professional caregivers, including the care manager, continue to provide care, and Lynn is required to cooperate with them.

As documented in the 5/18/22 text message Lynn's moms "unwellness" began and was voiced by Elaine on this day.

This "unwellness" was immediately reported to Liz Shifflett via documented text with 30+ texts between 5/18/22-6/30/22 as is documented by snapshots of the texts and text transcript.

According to Lynn, the care manager's behavior has negatively affected her mom's condition. Lynn claims that the care manager dismissed her concerns about her mom's noticeable decline in health, including fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain, and decreased appetite. Lynn also states that the care manager failed to act promptly when her mom needed medical attention, which led to a delay in hospitalization and treatment. Lynn believes that this negligence contributed to her mom's deteriorating health and her then current critical gravely ill condition.

Lynn Kay took several actions regarding the care manager's perceived negligence:

1. **Repeatedly Informed the Care manager:** Lynn consistently communicated her concerns about her mom's health to the care manager, detailing issues such as fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain, decreased appetite, and frequent nighttime urination.
2. **Insisted on Medical Attention:** She insisted that the care manager make a medical appointment for her mom, which led to a visit to a heart specialist on June 8.
3. **Demanded Immediate Action:** On June 29, Lynn told the care manager that her mom needed IV fluids and sleep, and on June 30, she urged the care manager to take her mom to the hospital, which the care manager initially refused.
4. **Escalated the Situation:** Lynn was repeatedly “called crazy” for Lynn seeking lifesaving care for her mom who was scared she was dying as isdocumented on Nestcam video.
5. **Lynn** had to yell at the care manager to finally get her to call 911, leading to her mom's hospitalization.
6. **Documented the Issues:** Lynn documented her concerns and the care manager's responses in emails to Cary Cucinelli, highlighting the care manager's dismissive attitude and negligence.
7. **Advocated for Her Mom:** Lynn continued to advocate for her mom's care and well-being, expressing her dissatisfaction with the care manager's performance and seeking better care for her mom.

The hospital finally on DAY 2, realizing Lynn’s request were “medically correct” responded to Lynn's concerns by taking several actions:

1. **Administered IV Fluids:** They provided her mom with IV fluids, which Lynn had been advocating for.
2. **Sedated Her Mom:** The hospital sedated her mom to help her get some sleep.
3. **Adjusted Medication:** They took her mom off furosemide, which was likely contributing to her frequent urination and inability to rest, and started her on a new blood pressure medication called Norvasc.
4. **Listened to Lynn's Pleas:** The hospital staff listened to Lynn's requests and concerns, including the need for a catheter and other specific treatments she believed were necessary for her mom's well-being.

The hospital took several actions for Lynn's mom's care:

1. **Administered IV Fluids:** To address dehydration.
2. **Provided Sedation:** To help her mom get some sleep.
3. **Discontinued Furosemide:** Likely due to its impact on her mom's ability to rest and its effect on her blood sugar.
4. **Introduced a Catheter:** As requested by Lynn.
5. **Prescribed Norvasc:** A blood pressure medication, which is given in crushed form mixed with applesauce.

These measures were taken to stabilize her mom's condition and address her immediate health concerns.

Overall, the hospital took Lynn's concerns seriously and implemented several measures to address her mom's health issues.

Lynn advocated for her mom's care in several ways:

1. **Consistent Communication:** She repeatedly informed the care manager about her mom's health issues, such as fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain, decreased appetite, and frequent nighttime urination.
2. **Insistence on Medical Attention:** Lynn insisted that the care manager arrange a medical appointment for her mom, which led to a visit to a heart specialist on June 8.
3. **Demanding Immediate Action:** On June 29, she informed the care manager via text that her mom needed an E.R. Evaluation and needed IV fluids and sleep. On both June 29 and June 30, she urged the care manager to take her mom to the hospital, which the care manager initially refused until Lynn insisted.
4. **Escalation to Emergency Services:** Lynn had to yell at the care manager to finally get her to call 911, leading to her mom's hospitalization.
5. **Documentation and Communication with Legal Counsel:** Lynn documented her concerns and the care manager's responses with snapshots of 30+ texts in multiple detailed emails to Cary Cucinelli, on 7/7/22-7/8/22 highlighting the care manager's dismissive attitude and negligence.
6. **Advocating at the Hospital:** At the hospital, Lynn continued to advocate for specific treatments, such as IV fluids, sedation for sleep, and a catheter, and ensured that her mom received appropriate care.
7. **Expressing Concerns About Future Care:** Lynn expressed her strong opposition to her mom being placed in a nursing home, advocating for her to stay at home where she believed her mom would thrive better.
8. **Personal Sacrifice:** Lynn emphasized her long-term commitment and personal sacrifices made to care for her mom, highlighting her role as a dedicated caregiver.

Through these actions, Lynn demonstrated her commitment to ensuring her mom received the best possible care.

Lynn raised several specific health concerns about her mom:

1. **Fatigue and Exhaustion:** She noticed her mom was drastically slowing down and showing noticeable fatigue and exhaustion.
2. **Reduced Fluid Intake:** Lynn reported that her mom was not drinking as much as she used to.
3. **Pain in Right Arm/Shoulder:** Her mom was experiencing pain in her right arm and shoulder, which Lynn initially suspected could be related to heart problems.
4. **Decreased Appetite:** Her mom began eating less and did not have much of an appetite.
5. **Sleep Issues:** Her mom was not sleeping well at night, frequently getting up to urinate, which was causing her to get very little rest.
6. **Frequent Urination:** Her mom was getting up multiple times at night to urinate, which was contributing to her fatigue.

7. **Potential Heart Problems:** Lynn insisted on a heart appointment for her mom due to the pain in her arm/shoulder and other symptoms.
8. **Need for IV Fluids:** Lynn believed her mom needed IV fluids due to her reduced fluid intake and overall condition.
9. **UTI (Urinary Tract Infection):** Lynn mentioned that her mom had a UTI, which was a concern for her overall health.

These concerns were communicated to the care manager and later to the hospital staff to ensure her mom received appropriate medical attention.

The hospital provided the following treatments for Lynn's mom:

1. **IV Fluids:** To address her dehydration.
2. **Sedation:** To help her mom get some sleep.
3. **Discontinuation of Furosemide:** Likely due to her mom not being able to rest and the medication raising her blood sugar.
4. **Catheter:** As requested by Lynn to help manage her mom's condition.
5. **New Blood Pressure Medication (Norvasc):** This medication was given in a crushed form mixed with applesauce to help lower her mom's blood pressure.

These treatments were aimed at stabilizing her mom's condition and addressing the immediate health concerns raised by Lynn.

8. Lynn's mom was prescribed Norvasc, a medication for lowering blood pressure. The hospital also discontinued her previous medication, Furosemide.

Lynn has been serving as her mom's primary caregiver and advocate. She has been caring for her mom full-time since 2011 and has been involved in her care since 2006. Lynn has also held the role of her mom's Legal Guardian and had Legal Power of Attorney (P.O.A.). She is responsible for preparing meals, monitoring her mom's health, and providing personal care, such as bathing. Lynn has been actively advocating for her mom's medical needs and well-being, especially during her recent health decline.

The care manager's response to Lynn's concerns was largely dismissive:

1. **Fatigue and Exhaustion:** The care manager attributed Lynn's mom's noticeable fatigue to being tired from multiple doctor appointments in early June.
2. **Pain in Right Arm/Shoulder:** The care manager suggested that the pain was likely due to contorting during a mammogram on June 1.
3. **General Health Concerns:** Despite Lynn's repeated reports of her mom's declining condition, the care manager continued to disregard these concerns.
4. **Hospitalization:** On June 30, the care manager initially refused to listen to Lynn's and her mom's pleas for hospitalization. It was only after Lynn was continually disrespected and continually called "crazy" that Lynn trying to save her own mom's life in providing "Emergent Care" got so angry with the absolute disrespect and disregard for her

“mom’s life” that Lynn angrily yelled at the care manager that she finally demanded that the care manager call 911 to have her mom taken to the ER.

Overall, the care manager did not take Lynn's concerns seriously and failed to act promptly on the health issues raised, leading to a delay in her mom receiving necessary medical attention.

1. **Medical Neglect Allegations:** Lynn Kay accuses the care manager, Liz Shifflett, of medical neglect and abandonment, leading to her mom's health deterioration.
2. **Court Order and Guardian Removal:** Cary Cucinelli informed Lynn Kay about a court order removing her as her mom's guardian, citing and threatening police involvement if she obstructs the new caregivers.
9. **Lynn's Advocacy and Care:** Lynn Kay has been her mom's primary caregiver for over 15 years, sacrificing her own life to care for her mom and claims there has been no neglect or abuse on her part.
10. **Health Concerns Ignored:** Lynn detailed multiple instances where the care manager ignored her mom's health issues, including fatigue, pain, and lack of appetite, which led to a hospitalization on June 30, 2022.
11. **Opposition to Nursing Home:** Lynn strongly opposes placing her mom in a nursing home, believing it would be detrimental to her health, and insists that her mom should continue to live at home under her care.
12. **Court Order:** Lynn Kay is ordered by the Fairfax County Circuit Court to cooperate with her mom's caregivers and not obstruct their duties. Liz Shifflet and Suzanne Hanas are authorized to contact the police if Lynn fails to comply.
13. **Caregiver Issues:** Lynn accuses the current caregiver of negligence and dismissiveness regarding her mom's health issues, leading to her mom's hospitalization on June 30, 2022.
14. **Lynn's Role:** Lynn has been her mom's primary caregiver for over 16 years, having moved back home to care for her full-time since 2006.
15. **Mom's Health:** Lynn details her mom's health decline in May 2022, including fatigue, reduced appetite, and pain, which she believes were not adequately addressed by the caregiver.
16. **The Court Order:** requires Lynn to cooperate with her mom's caregivers and not obstruct the provision of care. If she fails to cooperate or obstructs the caregivers, Liz Shifflet and Suzanne Hanas are authorized to contact the police.
17. The authorized caregivers for Lynn's mom are Liz Shifflet and Suzanne Hanas.

Lynn raised and informed about several health concerns about her mom, including:

1. Noticeable fatigue and exhaustion starting around June 2, 2022.
2. Reduced fluid intake.
3. Pain in her right arm/shoulder, which Lynn initially suspected could be related to heart problems.
4. Decreased appetite and eating less.
5. Difficulty sleeping and frequently getting up at night to urinate.
6. General decline in health leading up to her hospitalization on June 30, 2022.

Lynn also mentioned that her mom was not given IV fluids when needed and that her health issues were dismissed by the care manager.

Lynn took several actions regarding her mom's health:

1. Informed the care manager multiple times about her mom's noticeable fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain in her right arm/shoulder, decreased appetite, and difficulty sleeping.
2. Insisted on a VA heart appointment for her mom on June 8, 2022, due to concerns about potential heart problems.
3. Monitored her mom's sleep and nighttime activities using a Nestcam.
4. Urged the care manager to provide IV fluids and take her mom to the hospital when her condition worsened.
5. Advocated for her mom's needs at the hospital, ensuring she received fluids, sedation for sleep, and appropriate blood pressure medication.
6. Expressed concerns about the care manager's dismissive attitude and negligence, and requested the care manager's removal.

Lynn also emphasized her long-term dedication to her mom's care and her belief that her mom would not survive in a nursing home, advocating for her to stay at home.

Lynn advocated for her mom's health in several ways:

1. **Communicating Concerns:** She repeatedly informed the care manager about her mom's declining health, including fatigue, reduced fluid intake, pain, and decreased appetite.
2. **Insisting on Medical Attention:** She insisted on a VA heart appointment for her mom and urged the care manager to take her mom to the hospital when her condition worsened.
3. **Monitoring Health:** Lynn monitored her mom's condition closely, using a Nestcam to observe her mom's sleep patterns and nighttime activities.
4. **Demanding Hospitalization:** She strongly advocated for her mom to be taken to the ER when her condition became critical, eventually leading to the care manager calling 911, as Lynn had demanded.
5. **Requesting Specific Treatments:** At the hospital, Lynn requested IV fluids, sedation, and a catheter for her mom, and she communicated the need for proper blood pressure management.

Due only to Lynn raising the alarm on 6/29/22 and 6/30/22 as her mom woke up crying and scared that she was dying, as is recorded on Nestcam Video did her mom finally receive Antibiotics-(8 DAYS AFTER 6/30/22), though Elaine's organs and health were deteriorating already on Day 1-6/30/22, this was disregarded by Virginia Hospital with Elaine wrongly not receiving Antibiotics

Even with IV FLUIDS AND IV VITAMINS as Elaine was wrongly removed from IV FLUIDS on 7/4/22 and this caused the kidney infection urosepsis toxins to be built up with

Obstructive Uropathy, and the resulting Toxic Metabolic Encephalopathy was misdiagnosed as being dementia. Blood was found in the Catheter prompting IV Fluids to be restarted as only Lynn had stated when she noticed Elaine's belly was swelling and informed the nurse about this.

I have served as Mom's Legal Guardian, etc, officially or unofficially above and beyond for more than 15 years. And I had held LEGAL P.O.A..

There has been, absolutely, no wrongdoing or any negligence or any abuse or any neglect of mom, whatsoever, on my part.

Mom was absolutely more than thriving prior to June 2022.

I have been an entirely dutiful daughter in full-time caring for mom since 2011, when mom basically gave up on everything. And my helping mom since November 2006 when I entirely sacrificed my life now for almost 16 years for mom in moving back home as she had continuously been begging me to do after dad died in late 90's-(1998/1999) not sure anymore. I HAD INFORMED THE CARETAKER FOR MORE THAN A MONTH BEGINNING ON 6/2/22 THAT MOM WAS NOTICEABLY, ALL OF A SUDDEN, DRASTICALLY SLOWING DOWN AND THE CARETAKER SUMMED IT UP TO MOM BEING TIRED BECAUSE OF THE MULTIPLE DR. APPTS. IN EARLY JUNE.

ON 6/2, I TOLD THE CARETAKER THAT "MOM IS NOT NORMAL." IN ADDITION TO THE NOTICEABLE FATIGUE/EXHAUSTION THAT MOM WAS SHOWING, SOON THEREAFTER, I HAD INFORMED THE CARETAKER THAT MOM WAS ALSO NOT DRINKING AS MUCH AS SHE USED TO AND THAT SHE WAS ALSO COMPLAINING OF HAVING PAIN IN HER RIGHT ARM/SHOULDER. MY 1ST THOUGHT WAS HEART PROBLEMS AND SO MOM WENT FOR A VA. HEART APPT AT MY INSISTENCE TO THE CARETAKER FOR THE CARETAKER

MAKING A 6/8 APPT, WHICH MOM WAS SEEN.

THE CARETAKER SAID THE RIGHT SHOULDER/ARM PAIN WAS LIKELY DUE TO CONTORTIONING MOM DURING THE 6/1 MAMMO. I ACCEPTED THAT MAYBE WAS POSSIBLE, BUT THE PAIN CONTINUED.

THEN IN THE LAST WEEK PRIOR TO 6/30, SHE BEGAN NOTICEABLY EATING LESS IN NOT HAVING MUCH OF AN APPETITE AS SHE USUALLY HAD AND NOT SLEEPING WHILE IN BED AT NIGHT THROUGH THE EARLY A.M. AND ALSO WAKING ME UP.

SHE WAS CONTINUALLY GETTING UP MULTIPLE TIMES TO PEE AND GETTING VERY LITTLE SLEEP AND WHICH ALSO WOKE ME UP DUE TO ALL OF THIS AS I HAVE BEEN MONITORING MOM ALL NIGHT WITH THE NESTCAM ALL NIGHT TO SEE HOW SHE IS SLEEPING OR NOT SLEEPING, SO I COULD HEAR WHEN SHE GOT UP MULTIPLE TIMES THROUGH THE LATE NIGHT/A.M.

IT WENT ON FOR MULTIPLE NIGHTS, WHICH WAS ENTIRELY DRAGGING MOM DOWN MORE AND MORE EACH DAY.

I HAD INFORMED THE CARETAKER OF EVERYTHING AND SHE ENTIRELY DISREGARDED EVERYTHING.

ON 6/29, I TOLD THE CARETAKER THAT MOM NEEDS IV FLUIDS, MOM NEEDS SLEEP. I TOLD HER THAT MOM IS EATING, BUT IS VERY FATIGUED.

THEN ON 6/30, THE CARETAKER CONTINUED TO REFUSE TO LISTEN TO ME OR TO LISTEN TO MOM'S CRYING BEGGING ON THE NESTCAM FOOTAGE FOR MOM TO GO TO THE HOSPITAL.

THIS CARETAKER NEEDS TO BE IMMEDIATELY ENTIRELY REMOVED AS SHE HAS CONTINUALLY PROVEN TO BE ENTIRELY DISMISSIVE OF MOM'S HEALTH ISSUES AS I HAVE REPORTED EVERYTHING TO THIS CARETAKER AND SHE IS UNCARING AND NEGLIGENT IN CARING FOR MOM AND SHE SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE TO EVER CARE FOR MOM AGAIN AS SHE, ABSOLUTELY, DOESN'T HAVE MOM'S BEST INTERESTS AT HEART AS SHE HAS CONTINUALLY AND ENTIRELY DISREGARDED THE PLEAS OF HELP FROM BOTH MOM AND I, ON MY ADVOCATING ON BEHALF OF MOM.

ON 6/30, THE CARETAKER WAS CONTINUING TO BE DISMISSIVE OF MY DIRE CONCERNS FOR MOM'S HEALTH AND SHE STARTED TO LEAVE, UNTIL I YELLED AT HER THAT MOM IS ABSOLUTELY BEGGING FOR HELP AND THEN THE CARETAKER FINALLY CALLED 911 TO HAVE MOM GET HOSPITALIZED TO GO TO THE E.R.

AT THE HOSPITAL, THEY GAVE MOM FLUIDS AND SEDATED MOM SO THAT SHE COULD GET SOME SLEEP AND THE HOSPITAL ALSO TOOK MOM ENTIRELY OFF OF THE FUROSEMIDE, LIKELY ALSO DUE TO MOM NOT BEING ABLE TO REST RAISING HER

BLOOD PRESSURE WITH HER CONTINUALLY GETTING UP TO PEE AND NOT BEING ABLE TO REST.

THE DR.S AT THE HOSPITAL FINALLY LISTENED TO MY PLEAS FOR THEM TO DO EVERYTHING THAT I HAD SOUGHT FOR MOM, INCLUDING HAVING A CATHETER. AND THEY ALSO DIDN'T DO FORCED IV NUTRIENTS, WHICH I BELIEVE IS STILL NECESSARY FOR MOM AS SHE IS STILL NOT EATING VERY MUCH WHICH IS NOT GOOD. AND IS DRINKING JUST SIPS OF FLUID THROUGHOUT THE DAY.

THE HOSPITAL ALSO PUT MOM ON ANOTHER BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICINE CALLED NORVASC WHICH SEEMS TO NOW BE WORKING IN SUCCESSFULLY LOWERING MOM'S BLOOD PRESSURE. BUT IT IS A TABLET THAT IS CRUSHED UP AND PUT IN APPLESAUCE.

IF MOM DOESN'T EAT, SHE DOESN'T GET THIS MEDICINE FOR HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE.

I HAVE FOUGHT FOR MOM FOR 15 YEARS, ENTIRELY SACRIFICING MY LIFE TO MOVE HOME FROM CALIFORNIA AFTER 21 YEARS OF MY LIVING IN CALIFORNIA, JUST TO CARE FOR MY MOM, AS SHE HAD BEGUN BEGGING FOR ME TO DO IN 2004.

I AM ONCE AGAIN FIGHTING FOR MY MOM AND HER FUTURE WELL-BEING.

I HAVE BEEN FORCED TO BECOME MOM'S ADVOCATE IN FIGHTING FOR MOM'S LIFE AND MOM'S FUTURE COMFORT AND WELL-BEING.

MOM WILL DIE IF SHE IS PUT INTO A NURSING HOME. MOM NEEDS TO LIVE IN HER HOME OF 44 YEARS-(1978). SHE HAS EVERYTHING THAT SHE NEEDS AT OUR HOME WITH ME CARING FOR MOM.

MOM HAS A WONDERFUL HOME WITH MY CARING FOR HER AND MOM IS VERY CAPABLE IN ALSO CARING FOR HERSELF, BESIDES PREPARING ALL OF THE MEALS FOR MOM WHICH I DO AND BATHING MOM WHICH I HAD ASKED FOR HELP BECAUSE MOM BEGAN REALLY FIGHTING IT IN THE LAST MONTH FOR HER HAVING TO TAKE A BATH/SHOWER, AS THE CARETAKER ALSO HAD EXPERIENCED THIS WHEN TRYING TO GET MOM INTO THE SHOWER, WITH ME, SO I HAVE BEEN DOING THE LAST MONTH SPONGE BATHS.

MOM HAS BEEN ABSOLUTELY THRIVING AT HOME WITH ME UNTIL THIS PAST MONTH WHEN SHE STARTED NOT FEELING GOOD. AND STILL HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED WHY? EXCEPT UTI.

I HAD NO IDEA IF I DARE TO ASK FOR MEDICAL HELP FOR MOM'S WELL-BEING THAT

SHE COULD THEN BE PERMANENTLY PUT INTO A NURSING HOME, ENTIRELY AGAINST MOM'S WISHES.
